

PREVENTION AND CHILD EXPLOITATION POLICY

As Tasigo Hotels, we recognize our obligation and responsibility to operate in a manner consistent with the fundamental principles of human rights and we are committed to the prevention of and response to child sexual exploitation and abuse.

We keep deep concern about any form of child exploitation including:

- Physical, verbal, and sexual abuse from parents/guardians, other guests visitors, and employees
- Confinement (being locked in a room for long periods)
- Abandonment (being left on the premises without the proper supervision needed for a child)
- Pornography
- Trafficking
- Prostitution

We note the fact that any child/minor citizen might be at risk of child exploitation regardless of their background and current environment.

We are fully alarmed by the possibility of child sexual exploitation and any form of abuse happening in the tourism industry.

We keep in mind that the exploitation under the name of a relationship might seem consensual because of:

- The child's fear to speak/asking for help
- A possible sexual/psychological grooming of the child
- Gifts or punishments promised to the child for their public acts/behaviors



We believe that the staff and management must be alert in any suspected situations (especially the ones that include one adult and one minor citizen) for the best interests of the child/minor citizen.

We declare that any form of child sexual exploitation and abuse in the knowledge of our management and staff will not be tolerated regardless of their seeming consent or level

We hope to condemn any further damages and harm that could be done to the children under abuse and exploitation by informing authorities.

We support the guests and visitors to seek attention from the hotel in case they are informed of the possibility of child sexual exploitation or abuse.

We trust in informing authorities and legal charging to condemn child sexual exploitation or any possible form of abuse.

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
